

## Field Status Hotline Procedure

Both Anderson Park District and the Southeast Cincinnati Soccer Council Inc. have both established telephone call in numbers (Field Status hotlines) to report on field status. Each different hotline number provides different information.

The Anderson Park District hotline reports on the field status of Park fields. These are the fields at Clearcreek, Riverside, Veterans, Julifs, Firehouse, Beechacres, and Kellogg Parks. This hotline number will report if the fields are open or closed for games and practice use, and/or they may give a preliminary report on expected field status.

The first report from Anderson Park District Hotline is at 7:30am with an update on Saturday and Sunday at 11:00am. Based on changing weather conditions, updates may be put on either hotline later in the day based on revised weather or field conditions. For example, if rain develops the hotline may close fields at 2:45pm. Therefore, you need to continue to monitor the hotline during inclement weather.

If you have a game or practice scheduled at an Anderson Park District field, you must use the hotline number to determine if the field is open or closed for your use.

The Anderson Park District hotline may close a field at the 7:00 am report and if the weather or field conditions improve they may open the field in the later report.

The Southeast Cincinnati Soccer Council Hotline reports on field statuses of all fields (Anderson Park District and all other), but can also cancel or move games based on the status on fields.

**Changes may be made on both hotlines during the day, so your need to continue to monitor both hotlines during the times of inclement weather.**

When the weather is inclement or appears to be inclement, you must call and monitor both hotlines on game days prior to your scheduled time to receive all information that is important to you and your team.

**No one will contact you concerning field status. You must contact the hotline number for status of game or fields.**

Once games are canceled referees will receive the same information on the hotlines and will know not to show up for the game. Therefore, if the game is canceled or a field is closed on the hotline you are not responsible for notifying the referees or pay their fees. The hotlines are official notice. Remember, while the Anderson Park District hotline officially closes the fields, games can be moved to other fields on the Southeast Cincinnati Soccer Council Hotline, so remember to listen to both hotlines.

The hotline numbers are for the use of coaches, assistant coaches, team managers, referee coordinators, referee assignors, referees, club officials, parents, and players.

Remember the information that you need is on both hotline numbers, but it is your responsibility to call both numbers to get that information and then act upon it.
